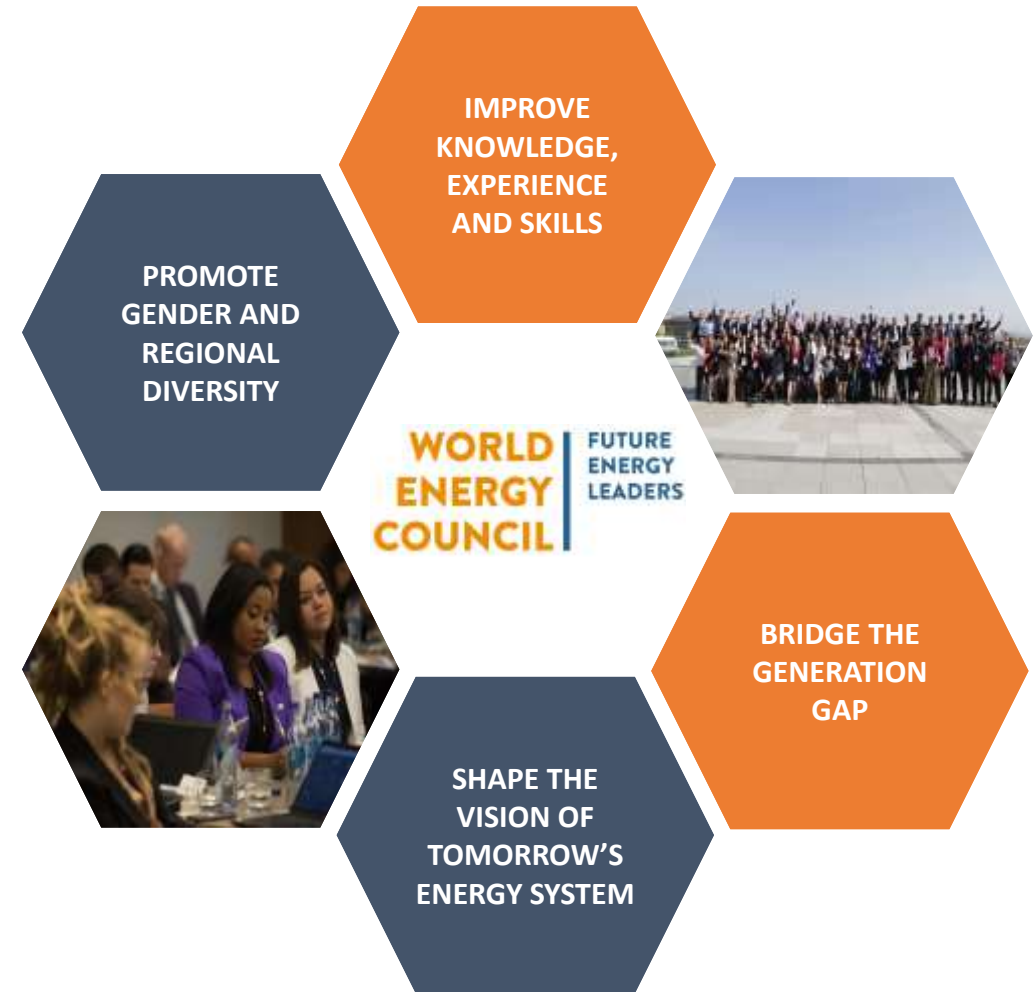


What is the Future Energy Leaders' Programme?

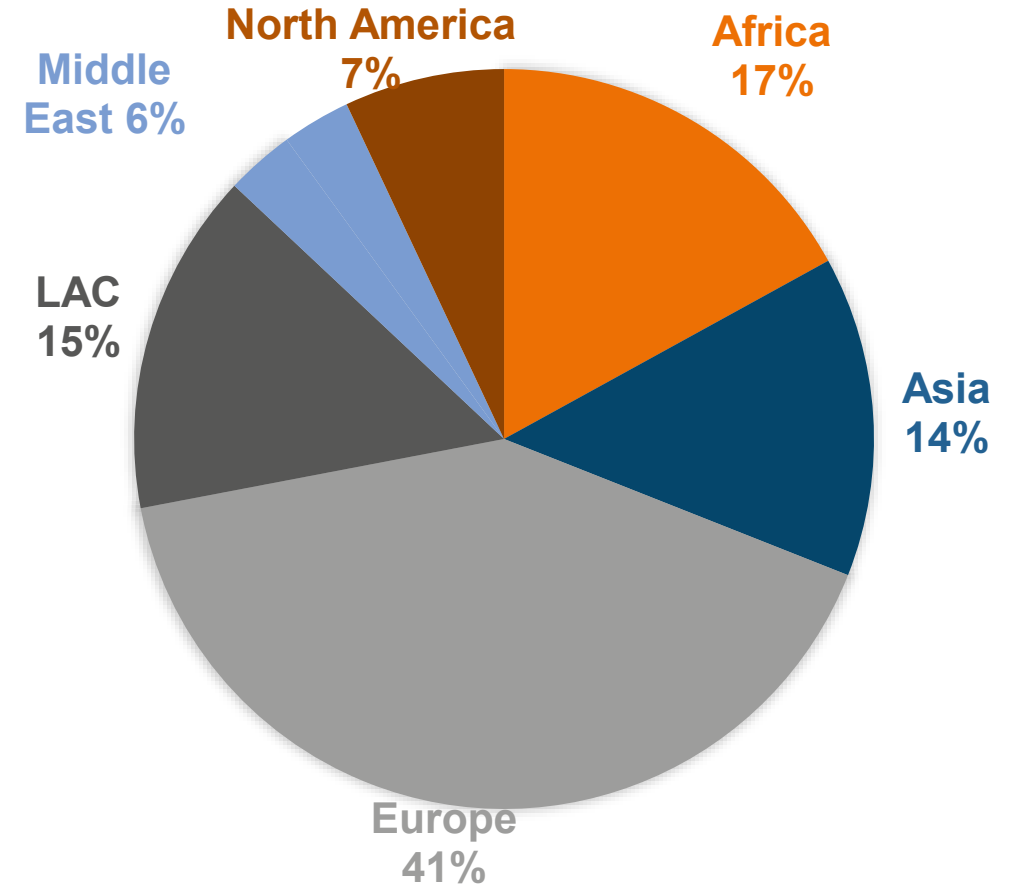
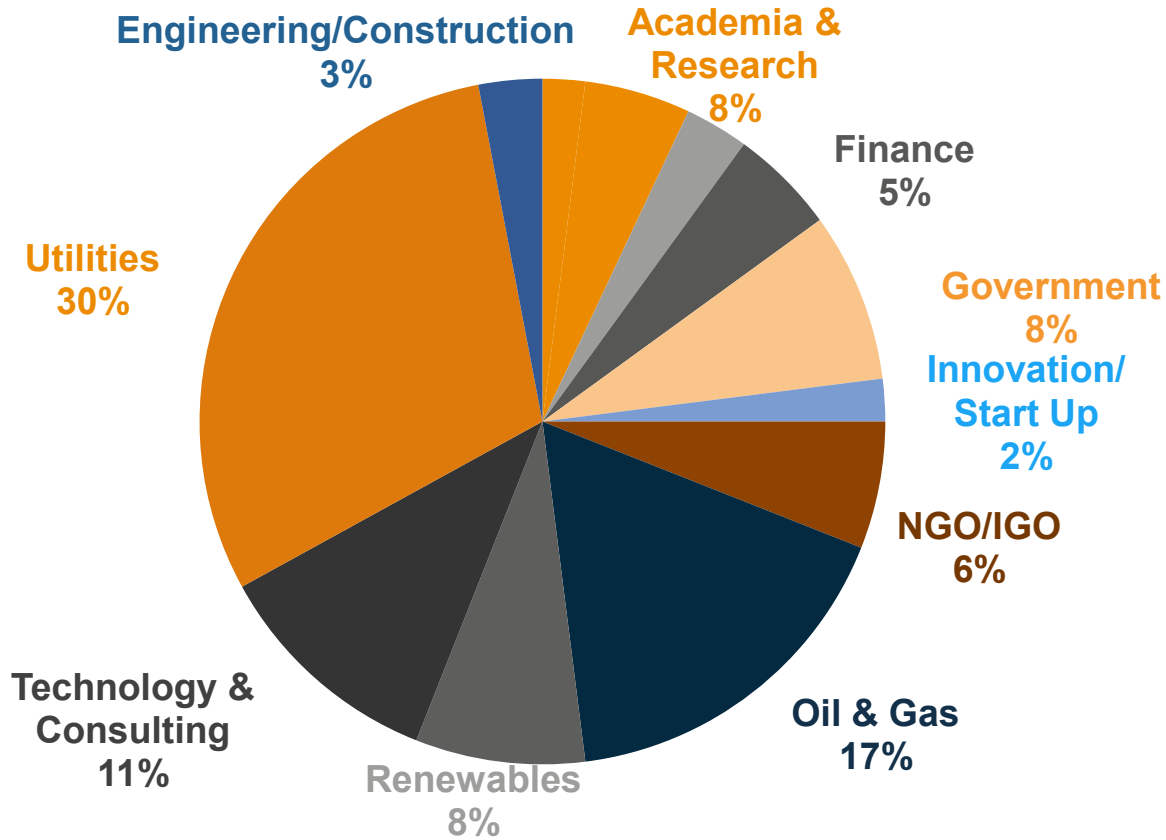

The programme, supported by Portuguese MC (APE) and liaising with the FEL-100 (Future Energy Leaders) programme of the World Energy Council.

FEL.PT members are invited to:

- **Contribute to the national and global energy dialogue**
- **Supporting local decision-making and political/regulatory efforts**
- **Contribute to design strategies**
- **Supporting the development of local professionals**

FEL.PT establishes a new programme that leverages on a **diverse and inclusive** network of **brilliant high-level young professionals** to create impact to **fast forward the energy transition**.

It offers young professionals a unique opportunity to **learn, develop** and **influence** the critical issues in the energy sector.

- **Development and sharing of a FEL.PT vision and strategy**

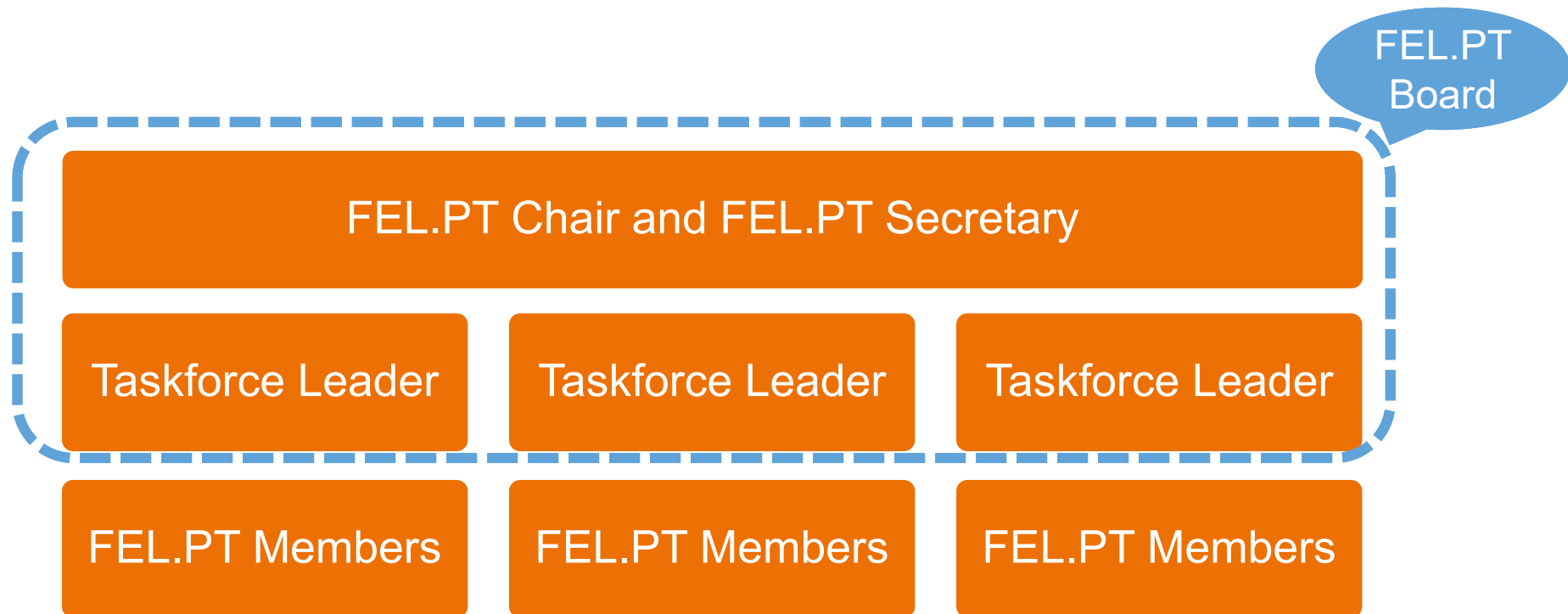

What we are trying to achieve:

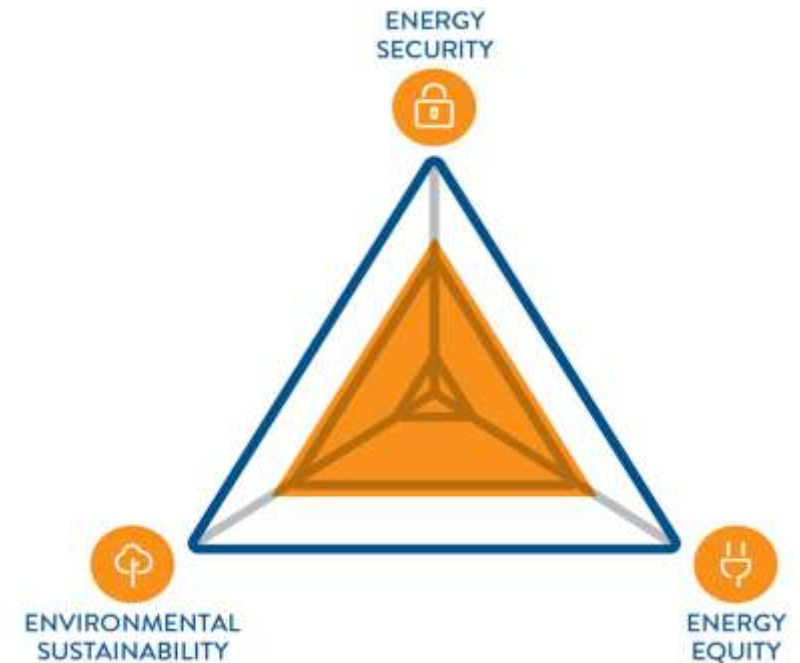
- Further engage the members of the FEL.PT community

- Provide a proper platform for initiating ideas and projects
- Expanding local knowledge regarding the energy industry

How does it work?

FEL.PT members have the flexibility to choose the type of project to work on within the assigned taskforces. The projects will be regulated by APE and FEL.PT Board to keep them align with our messages.

FEL.PT members also have the flexibility to choose topics of interest. The selection of topics will be based on ballot voting and the final approval will be issued by the World Energy Council Portuguese Member Committee.

FEL.PT participants will also be able to contribute to the projects using their own knowledge and experience and spread the Council's messages.



FEL.PT and FELs Events

- 1) There will be a FEL.PT Summit each year – organized by FEL.PT members and Portuguese MC (APE);
- 2) Portuguese Member Committee’s workshops, events and meetings such as – “*Conferência APE*” each year;
- 3) Every three years there’s a **FEL Congress** in parallel with the **World Energy Congress**, and **FEL Summit** are occurring every year during the **Council’ World Energy Week** – that **FEL.PT members** will be invite to participate.

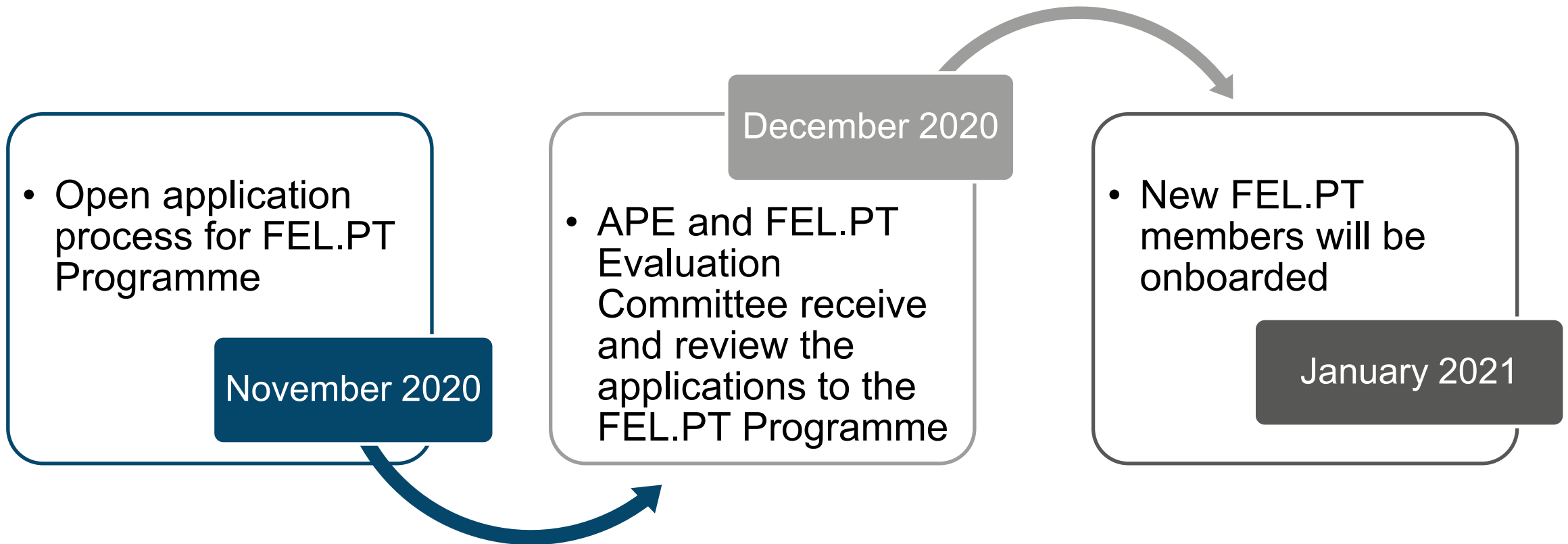
Application Process

Clear commitments, self-determination and continuity



FEL.PT application timeline



Eligibility criteria

Solid interest and proven track record in energy; the CV indicates a specific achievement and the potential to become a leader in the energy sector

Obtained a bachelor's degree or higher

Minimum of 3 years full-time post-graduate and professional experience in an energy-related field

Highly motivated and encouraged to work with the Portuguese MC (APE). Ready to show commitment to become a member of the FEL.PT, remaining engaged for at least one year

Advanced level of English as the programme and all communications will be delivered in English

Not be more than 35 years old at December, 2020.

How are Future Energy Leaders Portugal are selected?



- Every year some of the **FEL.PT members** leave the programme, and **new FEL.PT members will join it**
- The Portuguese MC (APE) and the FEL.PT Evaluation Committee will receive applications to the FEL.PT Programme during all **November 2020**.
- Applications may be submitted by a single person or by a company proposing their young professionals .

The programme strives for excellence, commitment and diversity.

- A diverse group which represents all Portuguese geographic areas
- Diversity of expertise & energy sectors and resources
- Promote gender diversity in the energy field
- Candidates with enough experience to contribute to the energy debate & put forward innovative solutions
